Most of the Council Members and Invited members checked in on 22 nd September, 2023 and they were all accommodated in the Guest House No.2 of IIT Guwahati. Except Meghalaya, all the delegates arrived by flight and volunteers of the Organizing Committee received them at LGBI Airport. Registration of the delegates was initiated from 4:00 PM at the Guest House with a free registration kit to every delegate. Delegates were welcomed at the Registration Desk with an Assamese Phulam Gamocha on the first day, i.e. on 23 rd September, 2023 there were 2(two) meetings, - one of CATE (Council for Advancement of Technology and Engineering) from 2:30 PM and other was CCC (Centres Coordination Committee) from 4:00 PM in the Conference Hall No.2 and hall No.4 of IIT Guwahati respectively.
